By Train

The Asian Civilisations Museum is a 5-minute walk from Raffles Place MRT station (Exit H).

By Bus

The Asian Civilisations Museum is a 2-minute walk from the Fullerton Square bus stop (03011), via bus services 10, 10e, 57, 70, 75, 100, 107, 128, 130, 131, 162, 167, 196, 196e, 700, 850E, 868, 951E, and 971E.

By Car

Drivers (drop-off only) can reach the Asian Civilisations Museum via a road behind Victoria Theatre and Concert Hall, via Parliament Place and Old Parliament Lane.

Public parking is available at the basement car park of the New Parliament House, National Gallery, Six Battery Road and at One Fullerton across from the Fullerton Hotel.
